Tools Needed: Power/cordless drill with Phillips bit and tape measure.

## Cover Clearance

Positioning the Mounting Brackets 8 " down from the top of the Spa shell, will require approximately $9^{\prime \prime}$ clearance behind the Spa. Mounted at this position, approx $75 \%$ of the Spa cover will be standing above the Spa surface in the off position.

Positioning the Mounting Brackets 12" down from the top of the Spa shell, will require approximately $15^{\prime \prime}$ clearance behind the Spa. Mounted at this position, approx 50\% of the Spa cover will be standing above the Spa surface in the off position. Illustration.

Position the spa cover (in the closed position) on the spa, making sure that all four corners are properly positioned and square on the spa.

Before attaching the Right \& Left Mounting Brackets (E) to the appropriate side of the spa, place the brackets where you will want them positioned on the spa and mark the holes. Mounting brackets should be installed $9^{\prime \prime}$ in from outside edge of spa lip edge.

1. Attach the right \& left Mounting Brackets to the appropriate side of the Spa.

Mounting height is your option.Use the \#10 $\times 1$ Screws(K).

2. Connect the Pivot Arm (A) and two Bushings (D) to the Mounting Brackets (E), using one $3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Hex Cap Bolt (F), two 3/8" Flat Washers (H), and one 3/8" Nylon Locknut (G).REPEAT

3. Insert the long arms of the Support Arms (B) into the ends of the Center Coupler (C) as shown. Narrow Spa and cover Installation Note: Flip the Support Arms (B) and insert the short side of the Support Arm (B) into the Center Coupler (C). Insert the shorter arms of the Support Arms (B) then into the Pivot Arms (A).
4. Lay the Cover Lift on the Spa Cover. Adjust the Coupler Bars and Support Arms so that the Coupler Bars are in parallel to the Spa cover hinge and about $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ behind the hinge.

5. Fasten the Cover Support Arms to the Side Pivot Arms and the Coupler. Be sure to rotate the Coupler Bar Pair so that the tapping screws are at a horizontal position with the heads facing towards the back of the Spa. Use the \#10 x5/8" self-tapping screws(J).
6. Lay the Lifter on the spa cover. Adjust the Center Coupler Assembly and the Support Arms (B) so that the Center Coupler Assembly is lying parallel to the spa cover hinge approximately $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ away.

7- Fasten the Support Arms (B) to the Pivot Arms (A) and the Center Coupler (C). Note: Be sure to rotate the Center Couplers so that the inserted screws are horizontal, with the heads facing toward the back of the spa. Use the \#10 $\times 5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Self Tapping Screws (J)

8. Press the decorative Large Black Dome Caps (L) over the heads of the $3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ Hex Cap Bolts(L). Then press the decorative Small Black Dome Caps (M) over the heads of all exposed \#10 screws (J and K). Note:A small amount of Glue/Epoxy will help secure screw/ bolt domes.
9. Attach the provided 3-Hook Towel Holder (I) on the preferred side of your cover lift by simply snapping it into place and inserting the middle Self-Tapping Screw (L).
