## Install Tips/Suggestions

To prevent splitting a wood cabinet, pre-drill holes with a $1 / 16^{\prime \prime}(1.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ drill bit. DO NOT REMOVE the bracket assembly CABLE TIES until instructed to do so in Step 6. Undoing the cable tie before this time will make the bracket arm spring up and make installation difficult.

ACCESS must be provided to the cover lift lock lever.
TO USE your new Top Mount Hydraulic Cover Lifter, you will flip the spa cover back over the support bar that lays across the cover by the cover seam. Taking hold of the top corner of the lifter, lift the bar towards the back of the spa until the spa cover is in a vertical position. The top mount hydraulic lifter comes equipped with a safety lock that prevents the lid from shutting when in the open position.

To close the cover, lift the safety lock. Take hold of the top corner of the lifter and pull down towards the middle of the spa. Once the spa cover is lying on the spa, take hold of the top half of the cover pulling it up and forward to close the cover completely over the spa. Lock Cover.

1. Position the spa cover (in closed covered position) on the spa, making sure that a four corners are properly positioned and square on the spa.
2. Next slide the closed cover far enough forward to allow for frame and bracket to be connected to spa. Figure A.

3. Attached the Left \& Right Mounting Brackets Assembly to the appropriate side of the Spa Cabinet (using \#10×1 mounting screws) Brackets must be fitted underneath the acrylic edge and between $4^{\prime \prime}-6^{\prime \prime}$ from the rear of the spa cabinet. Figure B

TIP- Secure brackets using minimum amount of screws at this point, then come back with the rest when everything is assembled and aligned. For spas with larger radius corners, you may need to skip the few holes that are closer to the pivot area of the mounting Brackets.
4. Take one of the Support Arms (D) and slide the thin retainer clip that's welded to the sup-

(Fig. B) port arm Insert under the cover in between the 2 sides of the cover. The main support arm should rest on the top of the cover next to the hinge.
5. Slide the Center Coupler (C) over the end of the Corner Support Arm that's already in position. Take the second Support Arm and repeat \#4 by sliding the welded retainer under the cover. Slide the end into the Center Coupler. Figure C
6. Line the completed Center Coupler Assembly next to the center seam of the cover. Slide Spa Cover and completed assembly slowly back towards the LEFT AND RIGHT Brackets. Inserting Corner Coupling into Bracket Arms. NOW Finish adding \#10 x 1 wood screws you may have skipped in Step \#2 7. Turn Center Coupler so the self tapping screws face upwards. Therefore the screw heads will not stick into the cover. Once the cover is situated correctly and the support arms are fully inside the assembled bracket arm, Secure the Center Coupler to the support arms ( $\# 10 \times 5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ screws).


## 8. FLIP COVER OPEN ONTO/OVER CENTER BAR.

Attaching the Hydraulic Shock, first flip the spa cover over the lifter so it is folded in half, then manually flip the spa cover back to the open position. Snap the hydraulic over the Ball Joint.
IT IS NOW SAFE TO REMOVE ZIP TIES. Figure D

9. You may add the Towel Hook at this stage, using \#10x 5/8" screws. Install on the black screw head domes. A small amount of glue/ epoxy will help secure domes.
